Nellandra Henry - EA Level 2 Coach - Show Jumping

Nellandra Henry is a EA Level 2 Jumping Coach and Coach Educator based at Benell Park in Gidgegannup. Nellandra has trained and competed in UK and the US and still rides and competes in show jumping. Nellandra is excited for the 2024 season with her new horse Absolute Charmer as well as getting the younger home bred horses out. Nellandra is a full-time coach, her aim to help riders achieve their goals - no matter what size. Nellandra started her coaching career at the Claremont Therapeutic Riding Centre. The Centre caters for riders of all abilities and has had many representatives at the Special Olympics and on the Para Squads. Nell feels this has given her a unique insight to coaching and being able to work with many different levels of riders. Nellandra says: "I love being part of each riders journey, progression and partnership with their horse, whether it be a 4* eventer, GP jumper or a young pony club member & I have been privileged over the years to learn from so many talented coaches. I want to pay it forward and pass on what I have learned as a rider and coach to others. To me, it is critically important for young riders to receive good coaching from the beginning. It makes everyone's life easier, better and smarter for young riders to begin with a foundation of mutual trust, respect and correct skills."

Louise Hillman - EFA, NCAS & General Coach - Flatwork

Louise has been a qualified coach for 45 years, both here and in England. In more recent times she has focused on flat work to help riders across all disciplines to understand how dressage assists horses and riders to develop a strong partnership. For the rider, Louise provides both theory and practical sections to her lessons – riders get to understand why and how to do something as well as experiencing the feeling of doing it. For the horse, her focus is on harmony, responsiveness and suppleness – aiming for a happy athlete. As a rider Louise has competed in show jumping, eventing, hacking and dressage, with her focus in the last 20 years being on dressage where she has competed up to Grand Prix. Louise is a past member of both the WA Dressage Squad and the National Futures Squad. Louise is also a qualified Eponaquest Equine Facilitated Learning Instructor, and Master Herder Instructor.

Dan Foster - Local to International Coach - Mounted Games

Caters for Adults & Kids, all riding levels, skills for everyday riding

As a pony club member, I rode in 6 state Championship teams, represented WA 6 times and won the Australian Nationals once. I first started coaching when I went to Orange Grove (2005) and in the 6 years I was the club coach Orange Grove won the State Open Championship five times. In 2011 I coached the WA State Squad/Team where we placed 2nd at the National Championships, since that first year I have now coached the Junior state team 6 times with 5 wins and one 2nd place. I have been the PPMG squad coach for the last 3 years where the final teams have then gone on to win the open nationals twice and the juniors have come 1st and 2nd. In 2023 I coached the Australian Pony Club team in the International Mounted Games Exchange. This is an annual event for juniors where 4 nations – England, USA, Canada and Australia participate. The Australian team came 2nd with England winning by one point. My true passion however is teaching at clubs and showing riders/parents the beauty of this sport. Since 2011 I have coached at Pony Clubs across WA, dividing my time across as many clubs as possible. As a PPMG coach ultimately, you're the coach who focusses on the PPMG teams in a club but I aim to teach every group at rallies so my lessons are tailored to the group.

If there are riders who wish to continue on and make a PPMG team, then I'd love to help any parent/coach and give ideas on how to get a club team up and running.

Jo Worth - Coach - Lead Rein/First Ridden/Adult Riders

Jo Worth owns and runs Hillview Trails and Riding School, out Woogenellup way, Mt Barker for the last 21 years and teaches all disciplines and ages. Jo has been teaching at West Plantagenet Pony Club for 16 yrs but has also taught at surrounding pony clubs when needed, she is a favourite with all the kids and has a wealth of knowledge that she is so willing to share with her students. Horses are Jo's passion and she doesn't stop just at pony club or her riding school but she has also taught at the Stock Horse Youth Camp held at Mount Barker for the last 7 yrs, she was a coach for the Mount Barker branch of RDA and travels over the Great Southern Coaching and trimming horses feet. Lead rein riders need to be accompanied by a handler over the age of 16. The handler must hold PCWA insurance – whether it be open annual insurance, as a riding member or as a non-riding member.

- * Small Group Lessons preference will be given to those attending both days
- * Upgraded Ablutions & New yards installed 38 horse yards & 9 Pony Yards please only horses attending lessons to be on the grounds
- * Plenty of Camping room and room for portable yards
- * Strictly No dogs permitted on the grounds
- * Strictly No Stallions or rigs permitted
